Sacramento Asian Sports Foundation (SASF) Teens Create Dreams (TCD) Program was created back in the summer of 2010. My son Troy Ota and his buddies Jason Wada, Brandon Nubla, Brian Otani and Darren Nishi wanted to start a program to give back to the community.

Their quick response was this, "At our school, we have a couple of homeless kids and we want to help people them. We want to bring awareness of homelessness to others in the community and to help the less fortunate." The SASF TCD Board began with several goals in mind for the mission of giving back to the community. The first goal was to provide an avenue to expose the crisis amongst homeless teens and their families. The annual summer talent show venue provided a way to get the word out, and exposing the homeless epidemic by donating the proceeds for not-for-profit programs for

the homeless. Past donations were given to the following programs that support homelessness: Habitat for Humanity, WIND for Youth and the Sacramento Children's Home Crisis Nursery. 22nd Annual SASF Crab Feed A Rousing Success

On Saturday, November 21, 2015, over 800 hungry guest feasted on over 4700 pounds of Dungeness Crab. The food preparation, like cutting and marinating the spareribs, cutting the vegetables, cleaning all the utensils, frying the shrimp chips was done Thursday and Friday evening (6:30 pm to 10:00 pm). Then on Saturday morning at 6:00 am, the SASF cooking crew started cooking the fried rice, preparing the crab and cooking the spare ribs. At 12 noon, the magic of cooking the Chinese style ginger and garlic flavored crab commenced.

A separate group of volunteers came in Friday night to put down the protective floor covering and set up the tables. Saturday morning they decorated the table tops. It took over 100 community volunteers to help prep, set up, cook and serve the delicious crab and of course, clean up.

Luckily, the Dungeness Crab was purchased months in advance, so we were not affected by the recent ban on crab caught on the California and Oregon coast. The crab we served was cleared to be toxin free.

Don Lee and Gordy Low, and their fantastic kitchen crew prepared another scrumptious “all you can eat” Crab Feast. Kingman Louie helped emcee the event again, that night. Many of our guest left smiling, happy and content at the end of the evening. By 12 midnight, the table and chairs were put away and the kitchen was cleaned and we were able to call it another successful evening.

SASF completed two concerts in 2015 featuring Taiko Project and contemporary jazz group Hiroshima. Taiko Project performed on July 11 at our facility. Hiroshima performed for us again at the Crest Theater on August 26. SASF supporters were treated to two great evenings of riveting entertainment.

For 2016, SASF is planning to hold all future musical events at our facility. We are improving the acoustic and audio elements within our facility. Our goal is to have future concerts at our SASF facility, as opposed to having them offsite. We will be saving on the rental cost of offsite facilities as well as being able to sell the tickets directly to our supporters, without the normal "conveyance ticket fees" offsite facilities usually charge. By mid-June construction will start by adding sound absorbing panels to the concrete walls and installing sound banners in between the steel joist trusses to further reduce

sound reflection. The project will be completed just in time to welcome our new performer for 2016.

CARA-C from Los Angeles will be performing for us the evening of August 20. CARA-C is a Chinese Pop violinist who was nominated for a Grammy and had her own PBS Special. A Juilliard graduate and winner of the prestigious LA Music Award, CARA-C has graced many of the worlds' top stages, including Carnegie Hall.
